Option 1

About 100 acres of rainforest are cleared every minute. In 24 hours deforestation releases as much CO2 into the atmosphere as 8 million people flying from London to New York and destroys unique and irreplaceable ecosystems.

Selecting this option will secure one quarter of an acre of rainforest in the Peruvian Amazon, through Cool Earth. The land will be put into local trust and protected from deforestation to keep the carbon where it belongs and the plants and animals safe. Cool earth employs local people providing them and the community with a positive income from the rainforest and a secure future.

The Octavia Foundation supports individuals and communities in central and west London. In 2009 the Foundation assisted over 5000 local people through its various projects.

Acre is supporting the Gateways To Work project, which provides help and advice to those who face complex barriers to employment such as; disability, caring responsibilities or a lack of work experience. Octavia offer one-to-one long term mentoring that helps individuals gain the confidence and skills they need to get a job, work experience or training, and continues to support the individual once they find an opportunity to ensure they succeed in the workplace.
